PAGE 2 -- PARENT COMMITMENT AND REMINDER:

In any human relationships, unmet expectations will be a cause for occasional conflict. To avoid conflict as much as possible, we have attempted to lay out the expectations on the "Guidelines and Expectations" page of the website. Everything there was added out of a desire to function efficiently and according to high principles; not because any of us likes following a rule list. Because we are a weekly tutorial and dependent on parental oversight and responsibility, we ask you to read the information on the website and, as a reminder to yourself and commitment to this school year, to read the following carefully and sign below:

- I understand that Good Company Tutorials is not a school and does not take responsibility for my child's education. I am the home school parent. I also realize that, although it is not possible for all parents to stay in the building, I am encouraged to be there as much as possible.
- I have read the website (or re-read it if returning), including the "Expectations" page, so that I go into this year understanding how Good Company works and making an informed decision about our commitment there and homework requirements for each class. I will do my best to make sure my students understand these guidelines as well as reminders as they come out.
- Understanding that most of the work actually happens outside of the limited class time, I will oversee my student's schedule and homework, doing my best to have him/her prepared for every class. Sometimes we make mistakes, and sometimes situations change, but as much as possible I feel confident that we can successfully meet the expectations for each class for which we registered.
- Recognizing that careless testing procedures compromise the integrity of my child's grades, transcripts, and character, as well as that of Good Company Tutorials, when my student is sent home with an exam, I will carefully proctor it according to the guidelines. This means that I will watch that my student takes the test without any external help and without technology nearby, and I will seal the test in an envelope and sign the seal. I understand that cheating means a 0 on the test or assignment.
- I understand that e-mail is the primary means of communication between GCT and my family, the tutors, my student, and myself. I will check and read those e-mails regularly, responding to them appropriately.
- I know the importance of being in touch and will let tutors know whenever possible if my child has to miss a class. I also understand that the tutors are very willing to respond to my e-mails about their classes or my student's progress, and will be in touch with them about how to best handle missed classes.
- I have indicated on the registration form when my child(ren) will be in the building or on the grounds before, between, or after classes. If that changes, I will let someone know, as I understand your need to keep track of students on the grounds.
- I understand that, while it is okay for my responsible student to be in the building and on the grounds between classes, GCT is not expected to be a drop-off spot for socializing; I will do my part to pick up my child in reasonable lengths of time and to be willing to do my share in being another adult in the parking lot or building when I am available. I will take full responsibility for the supervision of my younger children.
- I understand that students are to stay at the building unless leaving at the end of their school day or with a parent. If my child is to drive himself/herself, I will let you know that ahead of time.
- When problems arise, I will follow the biblical guidelines (Matthew 18) of going directly to the person involved, getting other, appropriate people involved as necessary if the problem is still unresolved. I will also encourage my student to do the same.

** LICENSING FEE: *Tapestry of Grace* encourages parents to own the curriculum. Any family not owning the curriculum is required to pay a licensing fee, which allows us to photocopy from the material and use it freely without breaking any copyright agreements. We send this money directly to *Tapestry*. Your other option is to purchase the curriculum and have it in your possession. New, it will run about \$200, but it may be worth it to try to obtain a used copy, especially if you have more than one child. It does not matter how old the version is, as you will not actually be using it. You are also welcome to borrow it for the year and just have it in your possession. Be sure to get Year 4, and then do not pay the \$95.00 licensing fee per student. (We recommend trying to purchase used or even borrow/rent for the year, the curriculum.) This class meets for 5 hours, but you pay tuition for four.

The class registration fees are non-refundable after Sept. 2, but are applied to May's tuition. Registration fees are listed with courses, as these courses vary in length, and it is sometimes confusing. Registration fees for each course are the same as monthly tuition.
